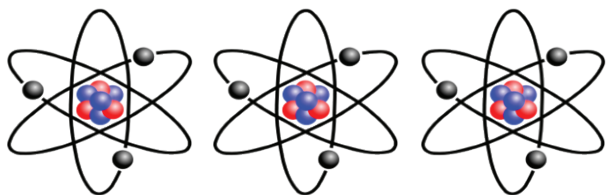


## Discover the Secrets of the Secret City

## Event Details

On Thursday, a **Manhattan Project Bus Tour** will visit several historic sites in the area. The tour will be narrated in person by Oak Ridge Historian D. Ray Smith. **The tour is limited to 50 guests, so you will want to register early.**
